DECISION

on adjustment of indicators for *Working package 3- 'Development of study programs in Public Health in ME'* in accordance with new Law of Higher Education in Montenegro

1. **New Law of Higher Education in Montenegro**

New Law of Higher Education in Montenegro was adopted on 30th June 2017 ([link](#)). Key changes with direct impact on implementation of PH-ELIM project include:

- New education system follows 3-cycle of HE education and scheme 3+2+3, which presents significant change compared to previous 4-cycle and scheme 3+1+1+3. All HEIs in Montenegro are required to re-accredit their programs in accordance with new law.

2. **WP3 indicators defined in PH-ELIM project proposal**

Indicators for WP3 related to new/updated courses/programs are defined as follows (pp 60-61 in PH-ELIM_Detailed_Project_description.docx):

- At least 1 new program accredited
- At least 1 PhD program updated
- At least 25 courses/curricula updated/established at ME HEIs in public health fields at all levels (expected values (at least): 7 BSc courses, 8 SSc courses, 6 MSc courses, 4 PhD courses)

3. **Decision**

In accordance with recently changed national Law of Higher Education in Montenegro, aforementioned indicators are changed by simple summing of indicators at previous scheme, and finally defined as:

- At least 1 new program accredited
- At least 1 PhD program updated
- At least 25 courses/curricula updated/established at ME HEIs in public health fields at all levels (expected values (at least): 7 BSc courses, 14 MSc courses, 4 PhD courses)

Additionally, new Law of Higher Education in Montenegro requires that **new Master study program** which will be developed and accredited as one of key PH-ELIM results, must have duration of 2 years (120 ECTS), compared to previous law (and planned 1 year-60 ECTS).
